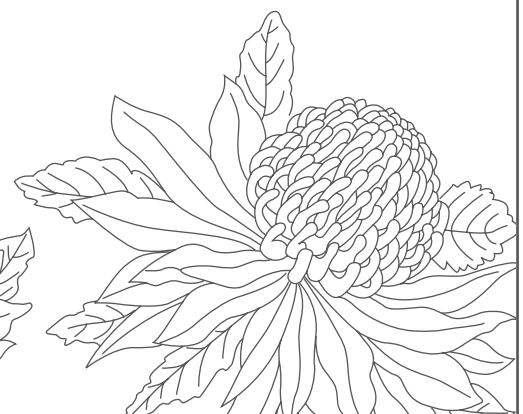

### **Important Stuff you need to know if you are exhibiting!**

1. The Great Australian Bag Challenge Entrants must use the Bag Challenge Entry Form & Guidelines.
2. It's a fun exhibition to show off what you have made, so ham it up and enjoy the experience!
- 3a. Your exhibit must have a **definite** Australian theme, so It uses Australian prints, for example Australian florals, gumleaves, animals & birds or Indigenous prints. **And/Or**
  - b. It has an Australian theme, for example appliqued or quilted Australian flowers, Australian style Beach boxes, Aussie Animals and Birds, Outback scenes, Australian Windmills, Southern Cross stars. Themes can also include Australian terrain, colours and natural occurrences such as drought, floods and bush fires!
4. If your Exhibit is to hang, it must have a sewn, tacked or safety pinned on sleeve at least 4" wide.
5. Your Exhibit piece must also have a label. On the back at a bottom corner for quilts, tacked inside hang bags or just on the back for table runners and similar projects. Small projects such as Christmas decorations etc we will catalogue and ensure their identification as best suits each exhibit.
6. Your Exhibit **must** be provided with an outer protective cover.
  - For quilts, a labelled **cloth** bag is required, with your name and phone number. We will **not** accept exhibits without a bag. We suggest a pillow case if you don't have a quilt bag.
  - For Hand bags and smaller items, boxes are requested so we don't squish them! If you don't have one, an Australia Post Box purchased from your Post Office is our preferred option.
7. Make sure you fill out all your details on your Exhibitor form, so we can best show off your beautiful work and return it to you safely!
- 8a. If you have posted your exhibit we will return it by registered post the week after the exhibition.
  - b. If you have delivered your exhibit to Chandler's Cottage it will be available for pick up during March. There will be several days on to which to do this, dates will be announced closer to the exhibition.
9. There will be a Viewer's Choice prize up for grabs so get sewing and bring your friends to vote for you!
