Important Stuff you need to know if you are exhibiting!

1. **Under the Australian Sun 10th Anniversary Challenge Entrants must use the separate Challenge Entry Form and Guidelines.**
2. It's a fun exhibition to show off what you have made, so ham it up and enjoy the experience!
3. Every exhibitor receives a fabric pack valued at \$50 from Leesa's fabric collections.
- 4a. Your exhibit must have a **definite** Australian theme, so It uses Australian prints, for example Australian florals, gumleaves, animals & birds or Indigenous prints. **And / Or**
 - b. It has an Australian theme, with detail such as appliqued or quilted Australian flowers, Australian style beach boxes, Aussie Animals and Birds, Outback scenes, Famous Australian People, Southern Cross stars. Themes can also include Australian terrain, colours and natural occurrences such as drought, floods and bush fires.
 - c. It may also be made of Australian materials such as Australian Wool, Australian plant dyes etc. Particularly if you have a lovely tea cosy, hat or scarf!
5. If your Exhibit is to hang, it must have a sewn, tacked or safety pinned on sleeve at least 4" wide.
6. Your Exhibit piece must also have a label. On the back at a bottom corner for quilts, tacked inside hand bags or on the back for table runners and similar projects. Small projects such as Christmas decorations etc we will catalogue and ensure their identification label as best suits each exhibit.
7. Your Exhibit **must** be provided with an outer protective cover.
 - For quilts, a labelled **cloth** bag is required, with your name and phone number. We will **not** accept exhibits without a bag. We suggest a pillow case if you don't have a quilt bag.
 - For Hand bags and smaller items, boxes are requested so we don't squish them! If you don't have one, an Australia Post Box purchased from your Post Office is our preferred option.
8. Make sure you fill out all your details on your Exhibitor form, so we can best show off your beautiful work and return it to you safely! See Form for more details.
- 9a. If you have posted your exhibit we will return it by registered post the week after the exhibition.
 - b. If you have delivered your exhibit to Chandler's Cottage it will be available for pick up from Wednesday 2nd December to Friday 11th December 10am - 4pm or by appointment.
10. There will be a Who's Who Viewers Choice Prize, judged by five mystery (very swish) judges at our VIP night on Monday 23rd November.
